Botox:

The presentation will include an introduction to the history and new developments on the horizon of Botulinum Toxin A as well as a brief analysis of Botulinum Toxin B. Significant focus on pertinent facial anatomy and physiology will be presented (the cornerstone to safe and effective treatment). The presentation will include mechanism of action, safety and efficacy issues, management and treatment of complications, dilution guidelines, and comprehensive information on proper injection techniques and placement, for the desired outcome. Our intense hands-on session will include identifying and mapping areas for injection and actually doing the injections.

Fillers:

This 1-day intensive hands-on training workshop will present the history, development, and characteristics of dermal fillers (Collagen, Teosyal, Restylane, Juvederm, Radiesse, Prevelle, Sculptra, and Silicone).
